

Township Resolution 2007-01

At a Town Board meeting of Long Lost Lake Township in Clearwater County, Minnesota held on the 13th day of February, 2007 at 7:00 o'clock PM at the residence of Supervisor David G. Johnson, Supervisor, Supervisor Johnson introduced and moved the adoption of the following resolution, which was seconded by Supervisor Tom Ignawicz, and unanimously adopted by the town board of supervisors:

WHEREAS, Long Lost Lake Township in Clearwater County, Minnesota contains a number of township roads, and

WHEREAS, said township roads have been established by use and maintained for a period of greater than ten (10) years, first by the Clearwater County Commission sitting as the township board of Unorganized Township 143-37 and since November, 2005 by the organized Long Lost Lake Township Board of Supervisor's, and

WHEREAS, there may or may not be a record of said roads, recorded in the Office of the County Recorder of Clearwater County, Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, the Long Lost Lake Town Board has determined it to be in the best interest of the township, the public and all parties concerned to determine and record the center line location of said duly established township roads, and

WHEREAS, the Long Lost Lake Town Board has caused to be prepared an attached road map indicating the location of said town roads contained in the township, and

WHEREAS, the Long Lost Lake Town Board held a public hearing on the proposal on the 13th day of March, 2007 at 7:00 o'clock PM and that notice of said hearing was provided according to law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the roads listed on the attached Exhibit A are hereby determined to be the duly established center lines of the township roads and are established to the width of actual use and maintenance as has been carried out during the last ten (10) years.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that no claims are made against private property beyond the width of actual use and maintenance.

EXHIBIT "A"

The following is a description of the township roads in Long Lost Lake Township as shown on the attached township map:

1. Big Hill Road – commencing at the east side of section 8, Township 143 North, Range 37 West, at a point on Clearwater County 39, and then in a southwest direction into section 17, Township 143 North, Range 37 West, until a point where it changes to a northwest direction and then back into section 8, Township 143 North, Range 37 West, continuing into section 7, Township 143 North, Range 37 West, until a point where it changes to a southwest direction into section 18, Township 143 North, Range 37 West, and continuing on until the LaPrairie Township line where it continues into LaPrairie Township until the intersection with McKenzie Road, having thus traveled a distance of 2.50 miles.
2. McKenzie Road – commencing at the intersection with Big Hill Road in LaPrairie Township it continues within LaPrairie Township until entering section 30, Township 143 North, Range 37 West, where it continues in a southeast direction until the intersection with Chimney Road, having thus traveled a distance of 3.20 miles. It shall be noted that McKenzie Road is treated as a township line road and that costs incurred in maintaining this township line road are shared equally between LaPrairie Township and Long Lost Lake Township.
3. Chimney Road – commencing at the intersection of McKenzie Road in section 30, Township 143 North, Range 37 West, and then in a southeast direction until it terminates at the intersection with Clearwater County 39, having thus traveled a distance of 0.73 miles.
4. Seaberg Lane – commencing in section 20, Township 143 North, Range 37 West, at a point on Clearwater County 39, and then in a northwest direction into section 19, Township 143 North, Range 37 West, and continuing into section 18, Township 143 North, Range 37 West and then terminating, having thus traveled a distance of 1.98 miles.

The above descriptions of Long Lost Lake Township roads Big Hill Road, McKenzie Road, Chimney Road and Seaberg Lane are intended to give only a general location of said township roads within the Township 143 North, Range 37 West.

All roads identified on the attached Clearwater County map of Long Lost Lake Township, 143 North, Range 37 West, are classified as listed in the legend on the aforementioned attached map.

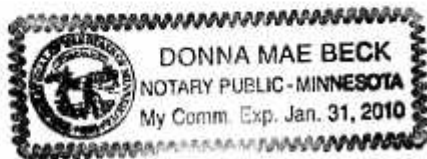

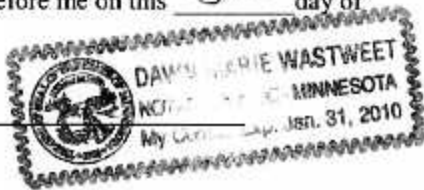

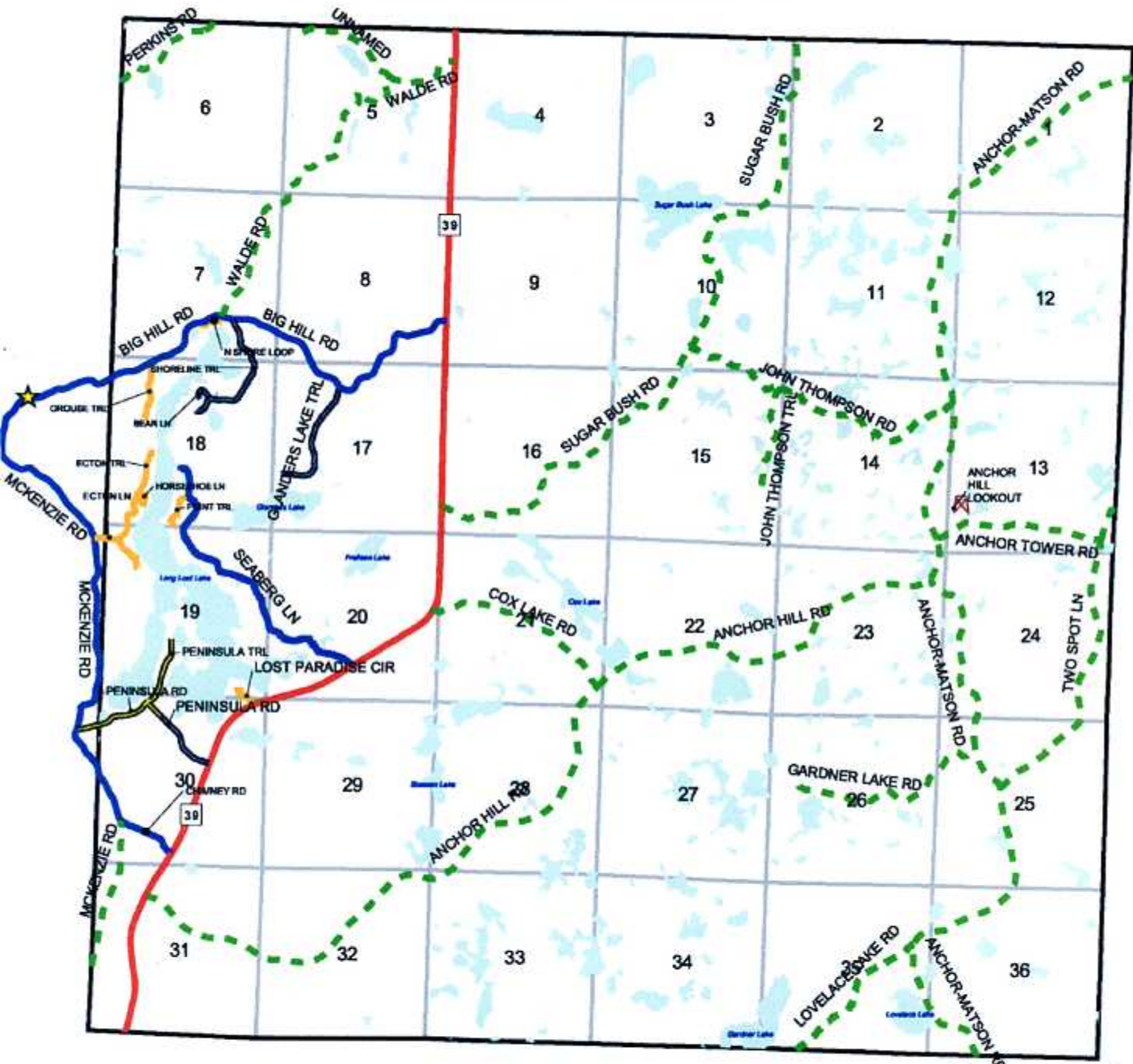
